INFORMATION FOR CLASSES

All classes to be run under BRC rules. (BS Rules where appropriate). **Classes 1 to 6** – Single phase. Each competitor will jump the whole course unless eliminated. There will be 5/7 fences in each section (max 12 fences). The height of the second section will be higher than the first section. The second section will be timed. All 4 members of the team will jump consecutively to encourage team spirit. The best 3 scores count. All team members are automatically entered as individuals. **First Aid** - £3 per rider

ALL CLASSES WILL BE A DRAWN ORDER

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Classes will be run under BRC Show Jumping Rules 2015 (BS Rules where appropriate).
- 2. Riding hats must be with BRC or BS current 2015 standards.
- 3. Mounted prize giving for every class.
- 4. Team entries to reach the Secretary by Tuesday 24th March 2015. Late entries on the day if space available (individual classes only) £2 extra.
- 5. Disclaimer of liability. The organisers or landowners shall not be liable for any claim for accident, loss or damage to competitors, onlookers, horses or any other animals, vehicles, property, equipment or any other item however caused. Competitors are to satisfy themselves they have assessed the risk factor in competing in the event. It is a condition of entry that each participant will satisfy themselves to their own ability and that of their horse to ride safely and indemnify the organisers against any accident or loss, however caused.

ANY NON BRC MEMBERS RIDING, HANDLING OR RESPONSBILE FOR A HORSE AT A BRC EVENT MUST HAVE THEIR OWN THIRD PARTY INSURANCE.

- 6. The decision of the judge is final.
- 7. Objections are to be made to the Secretary in writing, within half an hour of the disputed event together with a deposit of £10 which will be refunded should the objection be upheld.
- 8. In the event of cancellation, £2 of the entry will be retained to defray costs.
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, amend or add to the classes as they see fit.
- 10. Horses must not be left unattended whilst tied up to your lorry/trailer.
- 11. Please clear up all droppings, hay and litter.
- 12. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
- 13. Your signature on the entry form, or payment of an entry fee, shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the above rules and conditions.

Rules for Team Show Jumping

- 1. Teams to consist of three or four members. The best three scores will count. Teams to compete consecutively. One Junior may ride in a Senior Team but on a horse only.
- 2. No combination of horse/pony and rider may enter more than one team competition and no competitor may ride two horses in the same team.
